GOD IS GOOD! MHHS SAR MISSION + SSC KSAU TUGBOAT

After an intensive search and rescue mission, the crew of the SSC KSAU successfully located four missing outreach persons safe and sound on March 4, 2023, about 30 miles WSW of Angaur. The four individuals were boat operator Abraham Tatingal, psychiatrist Dr. Sylvia Wally, and nurses Minda Benjamin and Ruth Naruo, who were on an outreach mission from the Ministry of Health & Human Services.

On March 3 at 9:32 PM, Eric Whipps received news from Camille Reyes that the boat carrying an outreach team had gone missing. He promptly reported the incident to Mason Whipps, who instructed the crew of the SSC KSAU to assist with the search and rescue operation at sunrise. The crew, comprising Master Fasco Bawotong, Chief Engineer Edwin Absalon, Chief Mate Abu Taher, and ABs Razi Cboy Rimirch, Millong Orrukem, and Jemelo Abapo, had actually departed the Surangel dock in Airai at 05:20 PM, heading towards Helen's Reef.

After receiving the direct order from Mason, the SSC KSAU crew promptly changed course and turned back to Angaur to aid in the search and rescue operation. The crew was on high alert and ready to assist in any way possible to ensure the safe recovery of the outreach team.

The United States Coast Guard vessel Frank Hatch and the PSS Remeliik II were also contacted by Mason Whipps to assist in the search and rescue operation. The SSC KSAU crew coordinated with these vessels via channel 16, along with multiple smaller vessels on site and a PMA plane and Sea Dragon, to conduct an extensive search of the area.

Fortunately, the SSC KSAU crew was able to locate the missing boat and its occupants using the boat's GPS coordinates. The crew found the outreach team at <u>Lat 6deg42'50" Lon133deg38'38" Alt+72 ft</u>, and SSC KSAU towed the boat back to Angaur, where the team was met by the PSS Remeliik II and the USGS Frank Hatch.

The successful search and rescue mission was the result of the coordinated efforts of various organizations, the heroic actions of the SSC KSAU crew, and of course through the grace of God. The safe return of the missing persons is a great relief to their families, friends, and colleagues.

It is still unclear why the boat carrying the outreach persons failed to reach Peleliu. However, this incident underscores the importance of taking safety precautions and being prepared when going out to sea. As of now, there are no announcements regarding any follow-up actions or lessons learned from the mission. Meanwhile, the SSC KSAU will proceed to Helen Reef to complete their project with SSC Techall and return next week.
